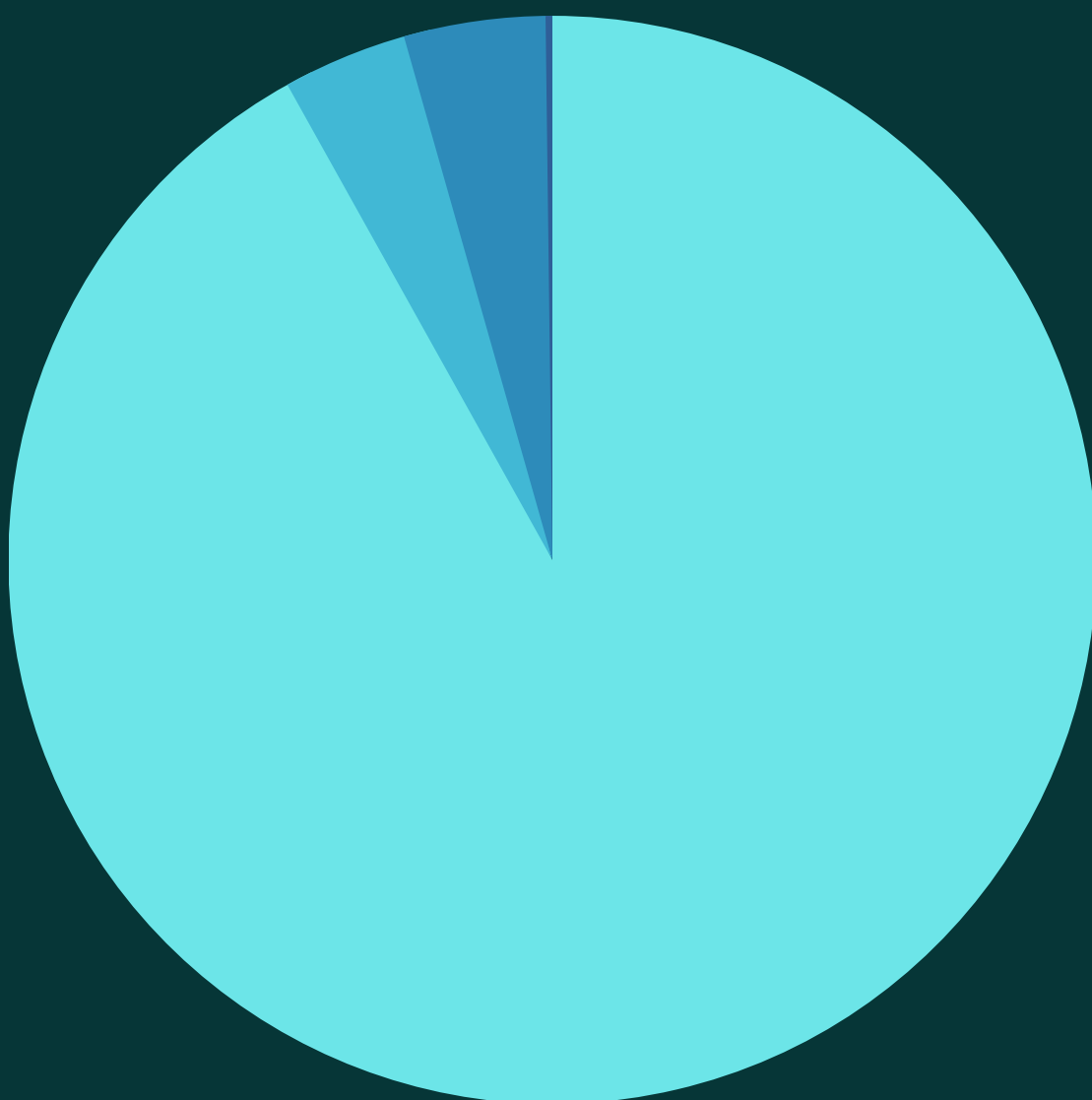

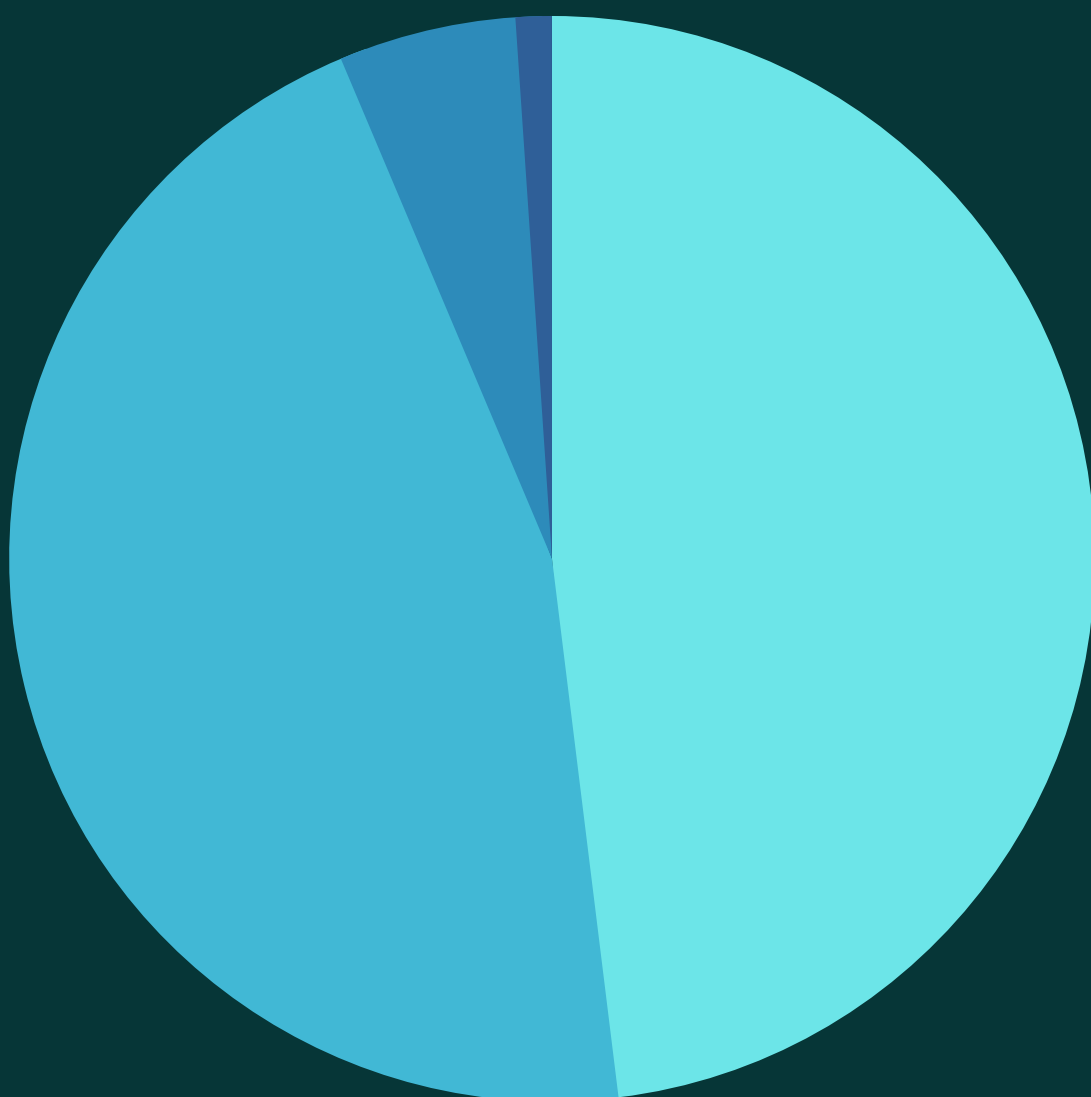
# ACCOUNTABILITY 2022-23
